- Name:** GEOFFREY FLETCHER ELECTIVE SCHOLARSHIP
- Eligibility:** Any Member of the Training Grades Group of the BOS. Applicants must be in good standing with the BOS and their appropriate professional bodies.
- Entry:** Aims of the proposed Elective
- Entry details:** A brief curriculum vitae
The title and aims of the proposed elective and the anticipated dates
A 1000 word abstract of the proposed study during the elective
The name of the Institution(s) at which the applicant proposes to work
A letter of approval from the Head of Department of the Institution where the proposed elective is to take place
A letter of support from the trainee's Training Programme Director
- Award Criteria:** Application demonstrates:
1. A clear plan / study protocol for the elective period
2. Benefit to the applicant's professional development
3. Feasibility of the proposed elective
- The winner will be expected to produce a report for publication in BOS News and other publications at the discretion of the Scholarship and Grants Committee.
- Value:** £3000
- The Elective must normally be undertaken within 1 year of the award being made; otherwise the prize money may be forfeited.
- Timing:** Entries to be submitted by January 31st each year on the appropriate Application Form.
- Sponsor:** BOS. This prize is available due to the generosity of Geoffrey Fletcher.
- Judges:** 3 judges, usually members of Scholarship and Grants committee, selected by Chair of Scholarship and Grants Committee to prevent conflict of interest.
