Psychology in orthodontics and psychology and application of patient-centred decision making – 5 hours CPD

Psychology in orthodontics

The first part of the pre-conference course will see Susan Cunningham, Tim Newton and Justin Shute talk about the psychological aspects of orthodontics. This will involve a contemporary overview of how to include these aspects in day-to-day patient care. Areas covered will include, how to include psychological assessment in practice, the increasingly challenging issue of managing patient expectations, and managing those patients who present with psychological concerns (including body dysmorphic disorder).

Psychology and application of patient-centred decision making

This session aims to provide an introduction to collaborative decision-making in clinical practice to support delegates to think differently about their role and the role of patients in the selection and delivery of orthodontic treatment. Psychological theory will be used to explain different approaches to decision-making, including informed reasoning, debiasing techniques and value clarification methods, using examples from dentistry and more widely across healthcare. Delegates will be encouraged to consider decision-making challenges they have faced in their own practice and possible solutions using patient-centred approaches.
