TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS FOR REVISION OF THE ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION FROM 1ST JANUARY 2013

1. The Articles of Association of the British Orthodontic Society as revised September 2011 (“the old Articles”) shall remain in force until 31st December 2012 at which time they shall lapse except as provided below.
2. The document entitled “Proposed revisions to Articles of Association September 2012” sets out proposed revisions to the Articles of Association (“the new Articles”) which shall come into force on 1st January 2013 except as provided below.
3. The office and duties of President as provided in the old Articles shall continue until 31st December 2015. The appointment of the President for 2015 shall be made by the Board.
4. From 1st January 2016 the offices and duties of President and Chairman of the Society shall be merged into the office of President. All references to the Chairman in the Articles of Association shall be deemed to refer to the President from that date onwards and the Articles shall read thus from that date.
5. The General Members of the Board as provided under the new Articles shall take office as Trustees and Directors from 1st January 2013. Two General Members shall be elected by the membership to serve a full term of office from 1st January 2013. The Chairman of the British Orthodontic Conference as previously elected to serve from 2013 shall become a General Member of the Board. Further General Members to a maximum of three shall be appointed not later than 31st December 2012 by the Board of Trustees to serve from 1st January 2013 for terms not exceeding two years at the expiry of which appointments the posts shall be filled by election in accordance with the new Articles.
